

Town of Dovre
Clerk/Treasurer Appointment Ordinance
Ordinance No. 2016 - # 02

The Town Board of the Town of Dovre, Barron County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 60.30(1e)(a), the office of the town clerk/treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members elect of the town board.

The term of the office for the appointed position shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed 3 years per § 60.30(1e)(c), Wis. Stat. The town board may re-appoint the officer for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during given term of office may only be for *cause* as defined under § 17.001, Wis. Stat. and § 60.30(1e)(f), Wis. Stat.

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held Tuesday November 8, 2016. The referendum question shall be:


"Shall the person holding the office of town clerk/treasurer in the Town of Dovre be appointed by the Town Board?"

The salary of the appointed position shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of the office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage, notice per §60.80, and upon approval in the above referendum as required by law.
