

TOWN OF DOVRE
SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING

The Dovre Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. on Monday July 24, 2017 at the Dovre Town Hall located at 304 25 ½ Street for a Special Town Board Meeting for a mobile meeting to look at town roads. Anyone is welcome to follow along.

Chairman Trowbridge called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Roll call: Supervisors – Al Nyhagen – Mitch Hanson – Dan North and Chairman Dean Trowbridge are all present. Jim Plummer is absent. Also Present - Patrolman Art Harelstad, Jr.

Pledge of Allegiance

1. Approval of Agenda: Motion by North second by Nyhagen to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried, unanimous yes vote.
2. Public Input
 - a. Patrolman Art Harelstad – has a map of the roads he would like the board to look at which totals about 12 miles. He also dated the last time they had been blacktopped.
3. New Business
 - a. Town Road inspection: The board left the building and proceeded to their first stop where Supervisor Plummer joined them
 - i. 6th Avenue – ¼ to ½ mile to the SS intersection
 - ii. 5 ½ Avenue near Jeff Larson’s property: the road is only 19 feet and it’s recommended the road should be wider due to the type of traffic
 - iii. 5th Avenue East of Jerdet bridge: Lane rutting and alligator cracks, heaved up culverts
 - iv. On the hill on 30th Street: the road is rough and rutted; the blacktop is from 1992, there is some patching around the culverts
 - v. 2nd Avenue East of Dick Wrights: The blacktop is from 1991 and is one of the oldest roads; there is no problem with the shouldering
 - vi. Barron/Dunn Avenue near the Wendt storage facility: Looking to use TRIPP funds next year to repair the road and knock down some of the hills for resident safety
 - vii. Barron/Dunn Avenue, east end – near the end of Dovre’s jurisdiction: looking to knock down some hills for visibility; the board discussed doing an engineering study and are looking into reducing the speed limit
 - viii. Cul-de-sac: someone has been scraping gravel from the road to the driveways
 - b. The board will ask the clerk to type up the minutes to be available for approval at the next regular meeting
4. Adjournment: Motion by Trowbridge second by North to adjourn. Motion carried, unanimous yes vote.
